SPIRIT OF TULSA SQUADRON

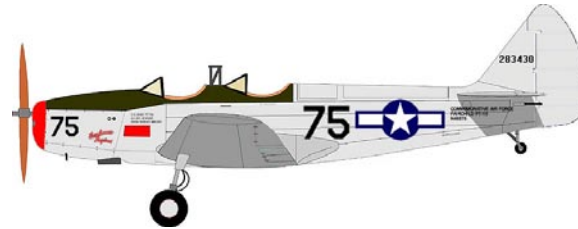

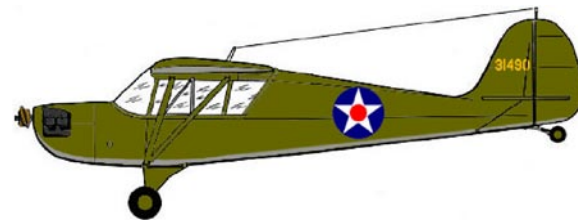
The Spirit of Tulsa Squadron is the local Tulsa area unit of the CAF, based at the Tulsa Technology Center, Hangar #2, 801 E 81st St Tulsa, Oklahoma (next to Jones

Riverside Airport). Our members come from all walks of life – teachers, lawyers, doctors, musicians, mechanics and pilots.

Current Projects of the Spirit of Tulsa Squadron include the almost completed restoration of a Fairchild PT-19 primary training plane, and the rebuild of an Aeronca 65TC Defender liaison airplane. Both aircraft are wood and fabric-covered, recalling rare craftsmanship, and need the care of both skilled and novice workers.



Activities enrich the hours of hangar work. Air Shows bring out our enthusiastic marshallsers for a ringside seat to radial engines, while our hams and hawkers peddle PX souvenirs. Our horizons have been further broadened by work and rides in other CAF aircraft, including the B-24A Liberator. The Squadron fundraiser 'Celebrate Freedom Big Band Hangar Dance' has found member talents not otherwise expressed!



The Cadet Training Program is available to youth ages 13-18. Cadets are offered educational and vocational challenges through participation in classroom activities, restoration, and all Squadron events. Particularly attractive is the ground school and opportunity to earn a pilots license. Several of our cadets are pilots, others have gone on to careers in aviation, and some just enjoy the history and hands-on experience.
